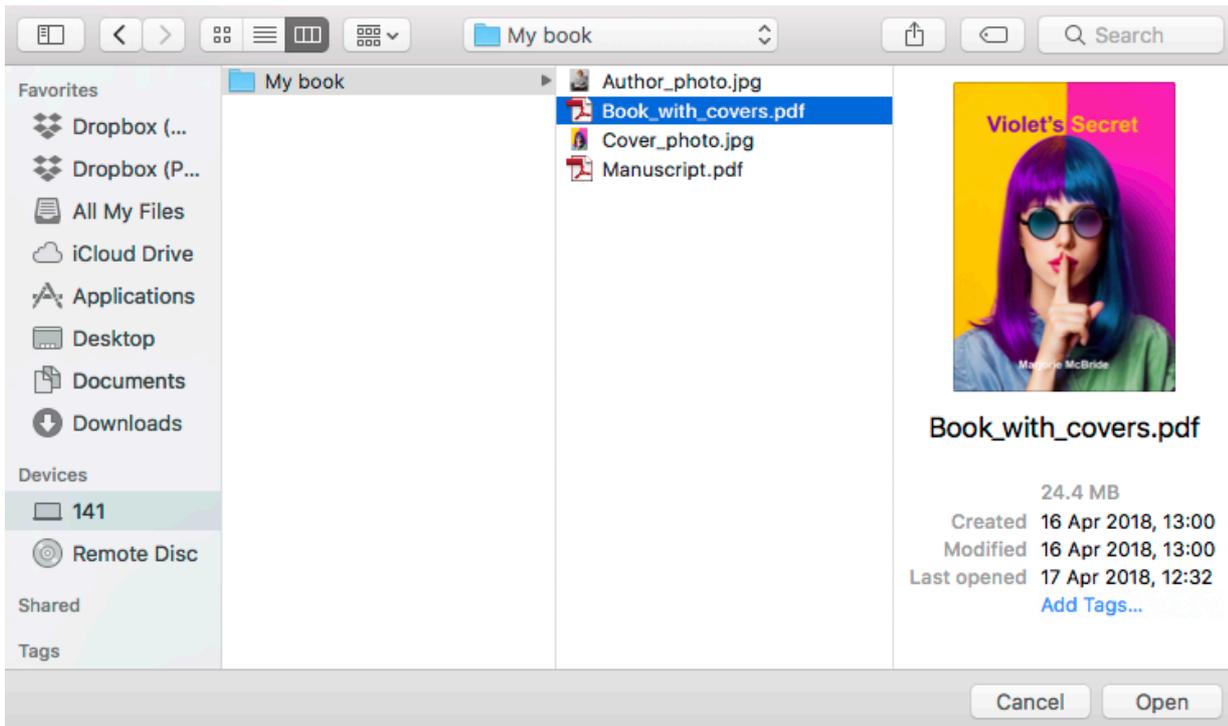

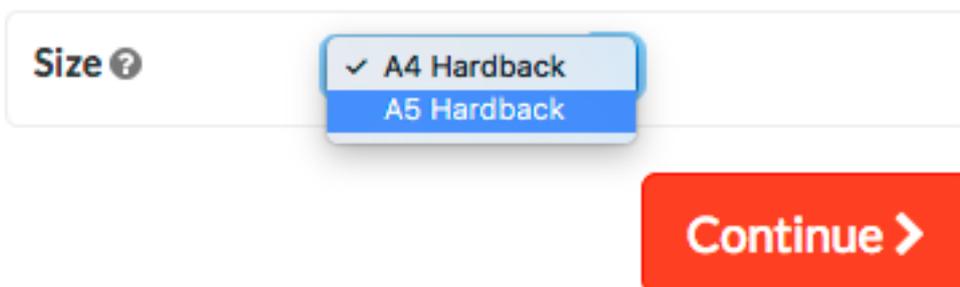

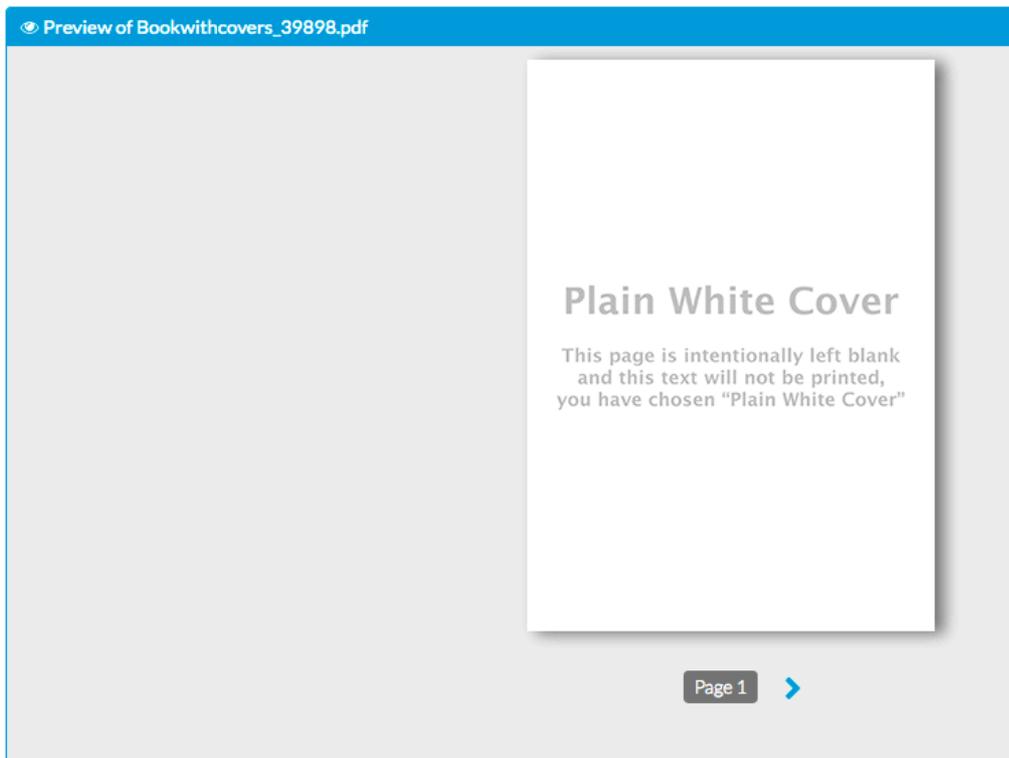
6. Select which size of book you'd like

- Upload cover artwork or create a cover in your browser using the Cover Designer.

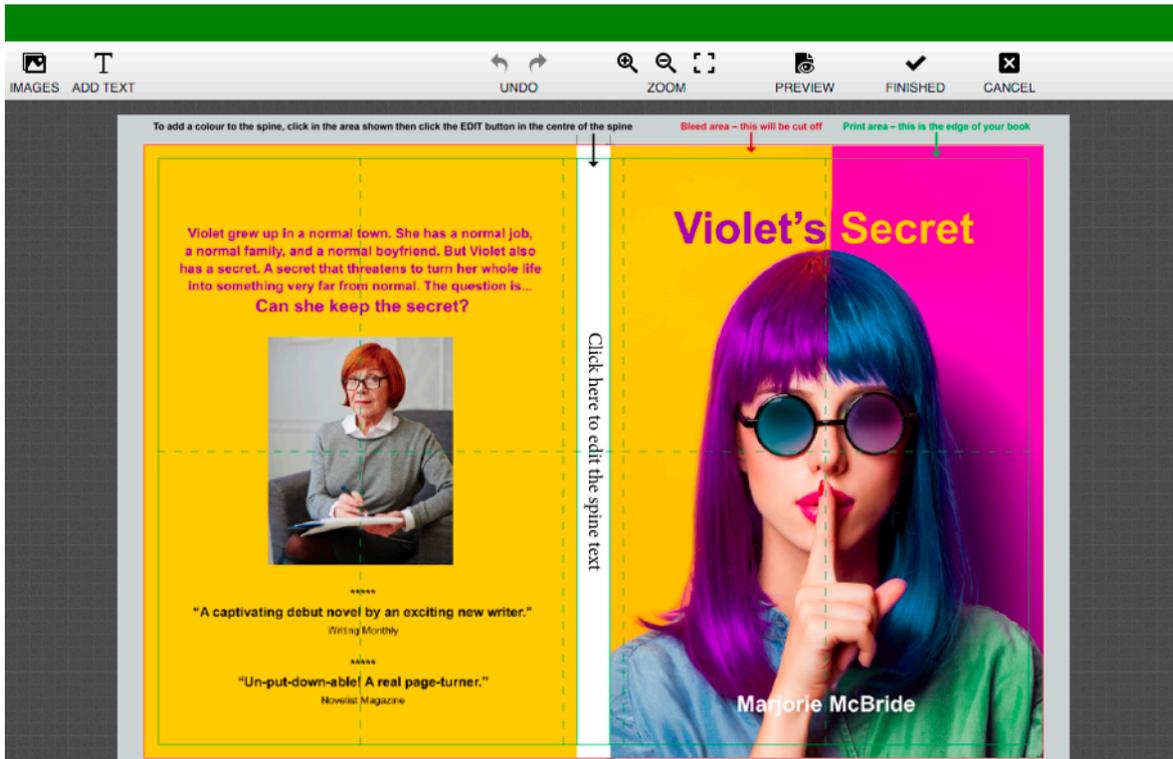
Option 2 Choose 'Use plain white covers' if you want blank covers (no cover design will be printed if this is selected).

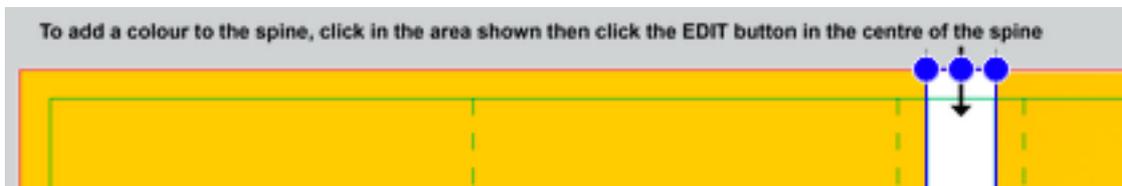

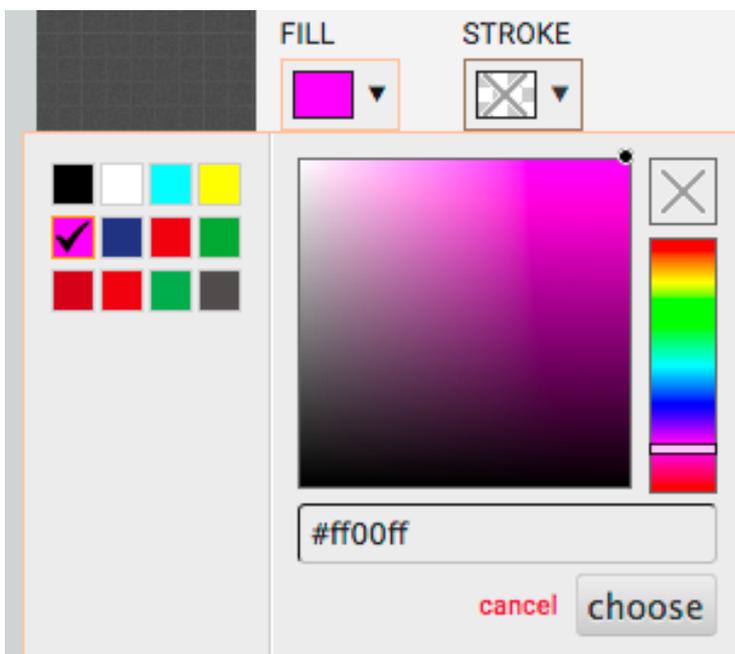
9. The cover designer will load and show you your front and back covers



10. To choose a colour for the spine click on the area shown below



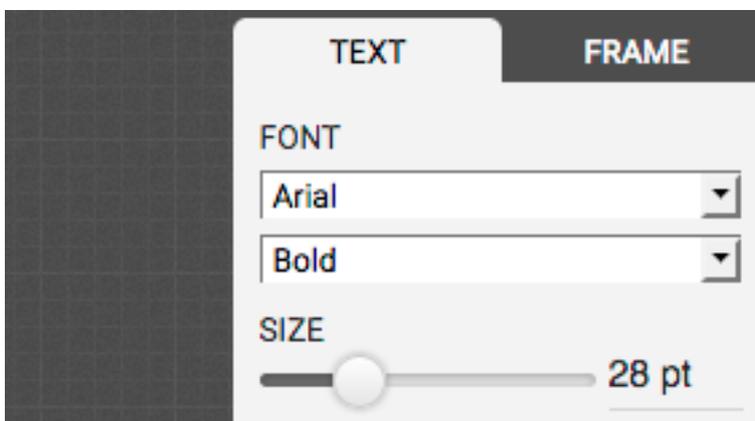
11. Then choose a colour by clicking 'Fill' and finding the colour you want



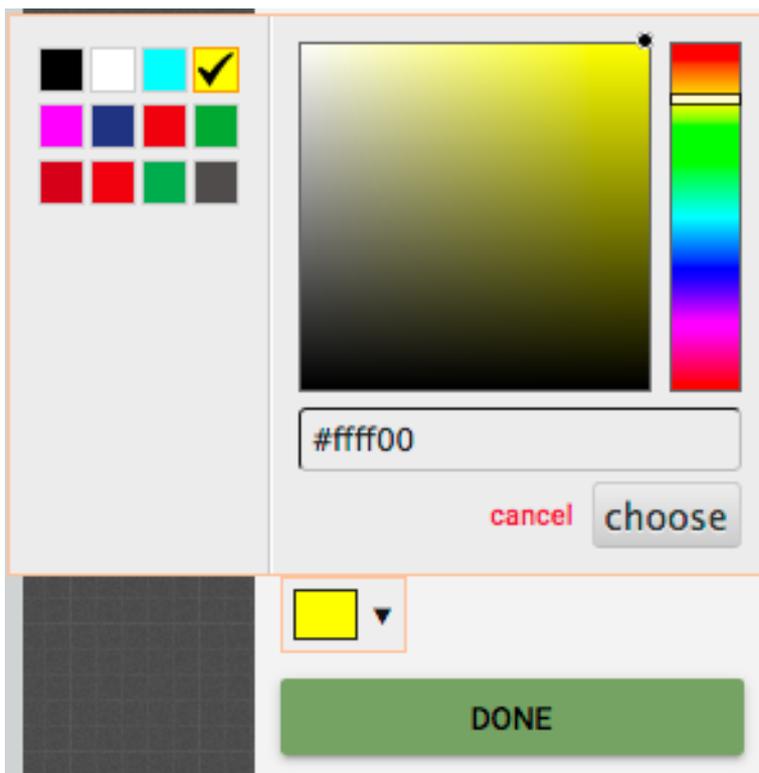
12. Highlight the spine placeholder text and type your book title and author (if required)



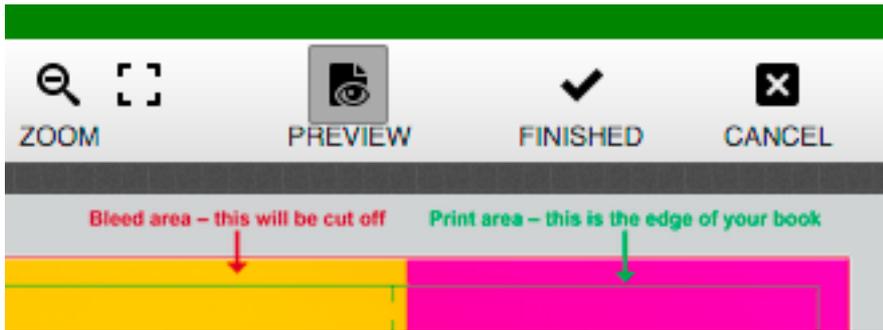
13. Select a font and change the size in the options panel to the right of your book covers



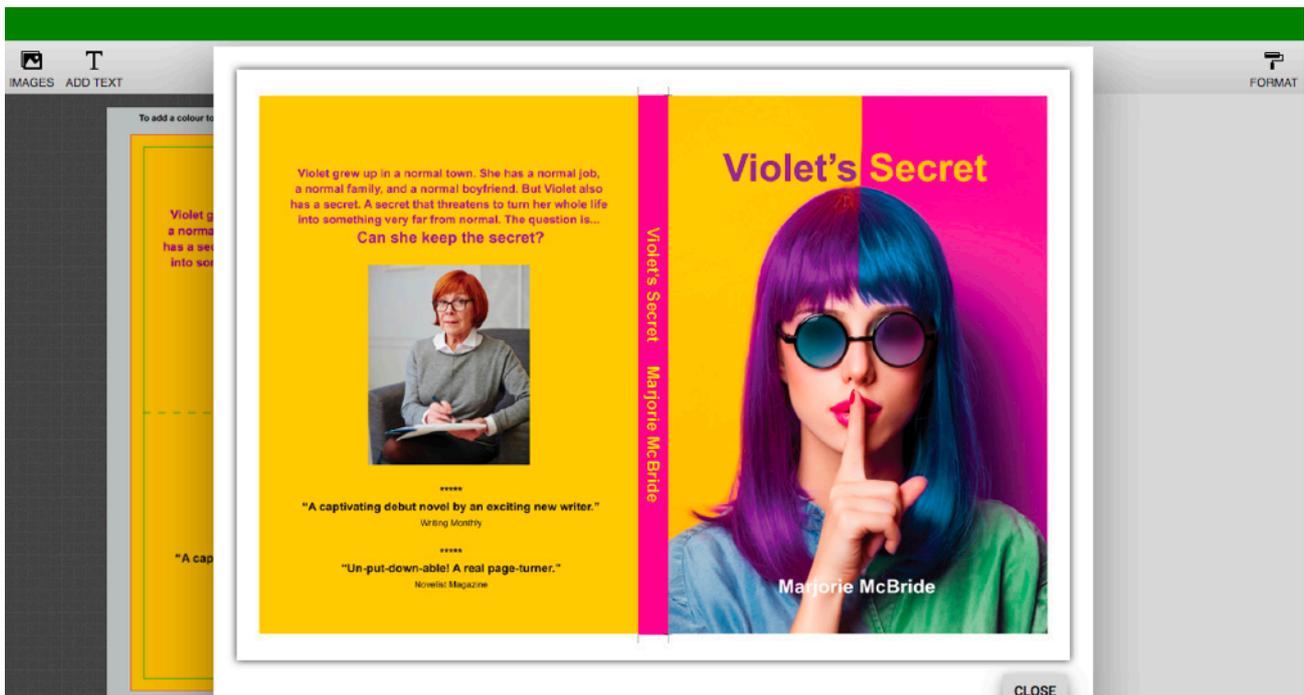
14. You can set the colour here too



15. Click 'Preview'



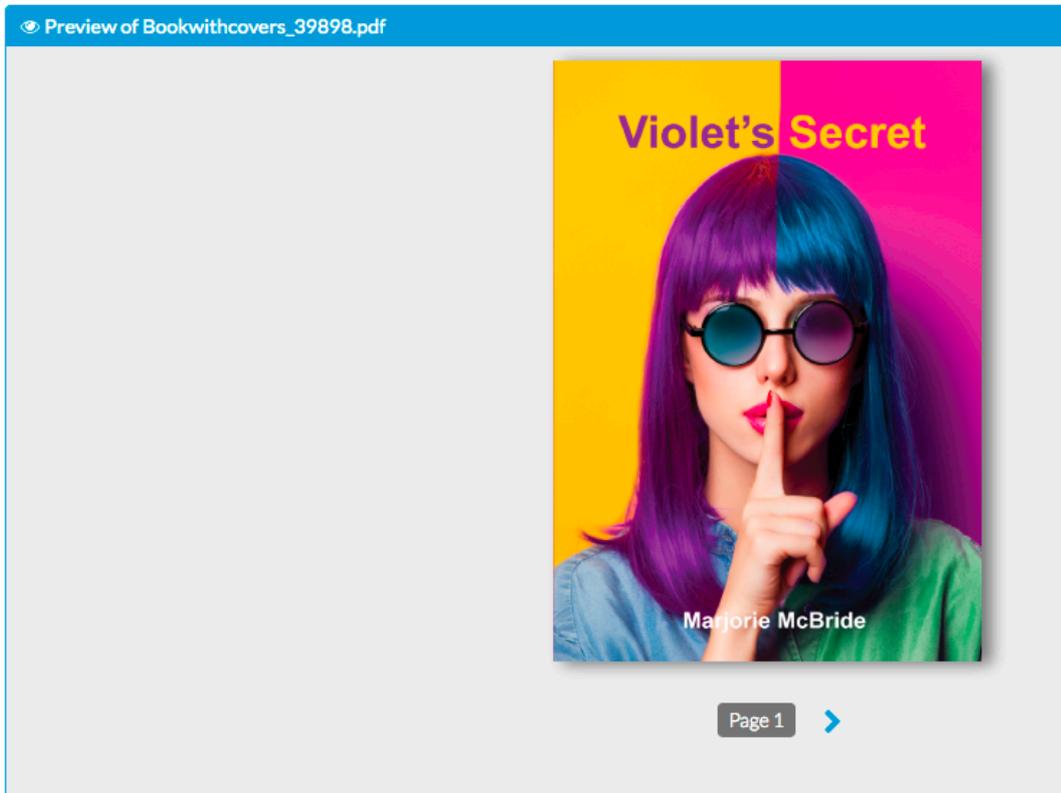
16. This will load a preview of how your complete book covers will look when printed

19. Options for the inner pages are available too

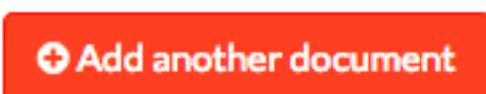
Design a Cover for your Book
